1. Background

Mukti Foundation is a local Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) started its journey in the southwest part of Bangladesh since 1996. The main concern areas of humanitarian and development activities of Mukti Foundation are to effective and timely humanitarian response for the people living in crisis, empower and establish rights of the less privileged, marginalized vulnerable communities, person with disabilities, ethnic community and improve environmental hazard through implementing multidimensional development interventions. Community and stakeholders inclusion are the focus areas of all activities of the organization. Mukti Foundation got registration from NGO Affairs Bureau, Society Act, Social Welfare and Micro Credit Regulatory of the Government of Bangladesh.

With the support of Malteser International, Mukti Foundation has been implementing a localization project titled "ToGETHER! - Towards Greater Effectiveness and Timeliness in Humanitarian Emergency Response" in Bangladesh since 2021. The project aims to transcend organizational boundaries, enabling local and international partners to develop approaches to humanitarian responses and create synergies during crisis response collaboratively. It also supports local actors in enhancing their capabilities in humanitarian response, preparedness, coordination, and advocacy. Additionally, the program aims to create opportunities for establishing complementary partnerships and promoting the roles of local partners. Capacity-strengthening and exchange measures are based on LHPs' self-defined needs and priorities, as well as the broader humanitarian context within their countries and contexts. **As part of the project's partner organizational capacity strengthening activities, Mukti Foundation is going to hire a consultant/ Consultancy firm to develop an Environmental Policy for Mukti Foundation.**
